

HUD Funding Priorities



Ending Homelessness for all persons	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Effective outreach• Clear understanding of all populations & their needs• Use data to target those with most severe needs• Improve system and project performance
Creating a systemic response to homelessness	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evaluate system performance• Use coordinated assessment to create transparent process
Strategically allocating and using resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evaluate program performance and cost effectiveness• Integrate mainstream resources into the system
Use a Housing First Approach	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create process that is low barrier• System & programs are client centered• System and programs focused on quickly accessing housing

2019 HUD CoC Program NOFA



- Key Components
 - Competitive process – projects ranked in Tier 1 & Tier 2
 - Grant Consolidations – completed through the application process for renewal grants
 - Expansion Projects – renewal projects wishing to increase capacity
 - Reallocation – funding process to create new projects
 - Bonus Funds
 - General Bonus
 - DV Bonus

- May only apply for the budget amount and line items approved in the most recent grant award

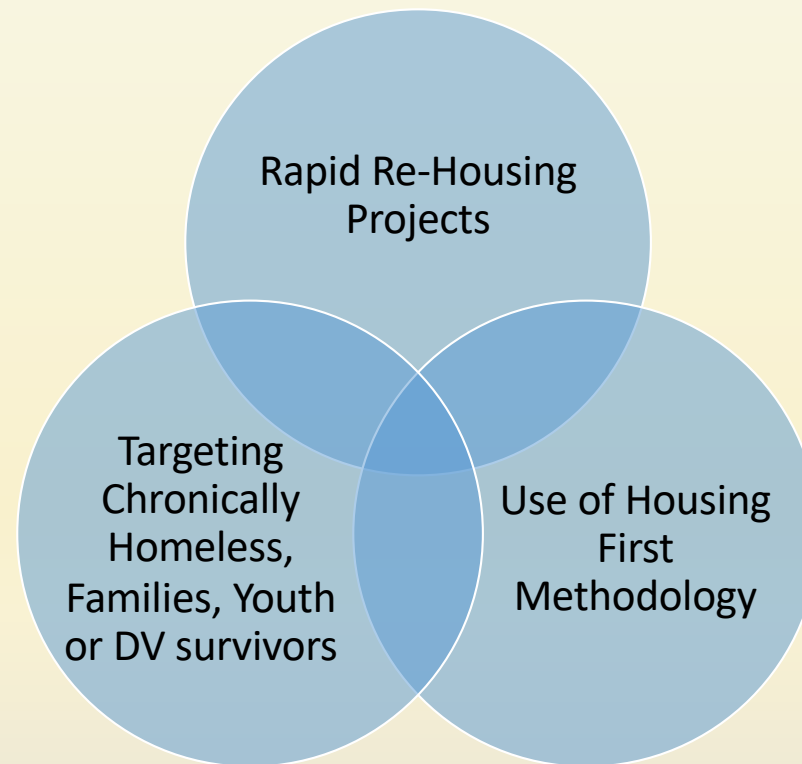
